Die plates



As the core component of granulation, the granulation hole plate is often underestimated in its function. It has rheologically optimized flow channels and is manufactured for the specific application. This depends on the product to be processed, but also on its influencing factors.

Is there a high mechanical load, is corrosion to be expected, or is the wear too high?

All of these questions form the basis for production at the highest level and can be eliminated through the targeted use of optimized materials.
